

Beachwood Brewing Growler Fill Policy

Beachwood Brewing's growler fill policy reflects clarification by the ABC governing growlers. In addition, it serves to ensure that Beachwood beer purchased for off-premise consumption maintains the highest quality standards possible. The Beachwood team works hard to provide the highest quality beer to customers; the growler fill policy acknowledges the value Beachwood places on the integrity and quality of our product.

Beachwood will fill the following 64-ounce growlers only:

- Beachwood branded growlers
- Blank 64oz stainless steel growler
 - o must have volume permanently denoted
 - o must include a cap that seals well
- Blank 64oz amber/brown glass growler
 - o must have volume permanently denoted
 - o must include a cap that seals well
- Any brewery 64oz amber/brown glass growler
 - o must have volume permanently denoted
 - o must include a cap that seals well

If the growler has any logos or brands other than Beachwood Branding, we will require that all the information be obscured. Beachwood will require the purchase of a growler label wrap that will completely cover aforementioned information.

We will not fill any growler that:

- Is made of clear, green, or blue glass.
- Has been obscured by the customer with tape or cellophane
- Contains a neck logo of another brewery
- Is dirty or poorly maintained
- Does not have its size clearly and officially stated on the container
- Is 32oz., 1gal, 500ml, 1L, & 2L
- Is ceramic or Hydro-flask
- Does not have its own cap or lid (excludes Beachwood branded growlers) with a seal in full working condition

Any growler brought to Beachwood must be properly cleaned. To ensure the highest quality of our beer, we reserve the right to deny a growler fill for any reason.
