Kali Hart Pinot Noir 2009 (Monterey County) \$9/\$31

Aromas of blueberry, cherry and plum are complemented by floral notes and hints of spicy cinnamon and a touch of toasty French oak.. On the palate, this wine delivers lush flavors of cherry-cola, blueberry, while echoing the cinnamon, rose and violet aromatics.

Pfneiszl Kékfrankos 2010 (Hungary) \$8 glass/\$28 bottle

This classic Kékfrankos otherwise know as Blaufränkisch (Austria) is a light-bodied red with aromas of raspberry, cherry and white pepper. Clean, juicy, food friendly acidity and a touch of earth. This is a refreshing red wine, great for Pinot Noir fans in pursuit of something new.

Sean Minor Cabernet Sauvignon (Napa) 2009 \$9 glass/ \$31 bottle

Deep ruby in color and displays aromas of ripe cherry, cassis and blackberry fruit. Flavors of blackberries and raspberries combined with hints of savory spices coat the palate. The soft tannins and sweet oak balance lead to a long and lingering finish.

Dom. de Cristia Haut Zone Ventoux 2009 (France) \$7 glass/ \$25 bottle

This delicious Rhone red blend (40% Syrah, 35% Grenache & 25% Old Vine Carignan) is full bodied with lush plum and berry flavors, white pepper and a hint of anise.

Trinitas Old Vine Zinfandel 2007 (Sierra Foothills) \$8 glass/ \$28 bottle

This classic zinfandel will coat your mouth with rustic flavors of raspberry and black pepper. The wonderful rich, spicy but fruity finish will leave you asking for more.

Riff Pinot Grigio 2011 (Italy) \$7 glass/ \$25 bottle

Brilliant straw yellow colour with a green tint. Fruity (apples, peaches), forward varietal aroma with elegant mineral notes. Quite pronounced, clean, grapey flavour. Dry, medium-bodied on the palate w/ a crisp & well balanced aftertaste & good length.

Cable Bay Savignon Blanc 2009 (New Zealand) \$8 glass/\$28 bottle

A combination of modern and traditional winemaking techniques has produced a wine with excellent fruit concentration, crisp acidity and generous texture. Ripe tropical and stone fruit aromas harmonious with capsicum and gooseberry characters. A creamy mouth feel adds backbone to a wine which delivers a long zesty finish.

Stanley Lambert Pristine Chardonnay 2008 (Australia) \$8 glass/\$28 bottle

A distinctively fresh Chardonnay kept in its pristine form by the non use of any oak. The wine displays soft pear and melon characters, juicy apples and a twist of citrus, with a crisp clean finish. Very refreshing!

Lost Canyon Chardonnay 09, Ruxton Vineyard-Russian River Valley \$9/\$31

The nose is fresh and pure with scents of orchard fruits with accents of clementines and hints of mineral and vanilla. The layers of fruit, mineral, and subtlebutterscotch notes are best uncovered with just a slight chill. Ideally proportioned with a long finish focused on semi-tart apples and citrus.
